Adobe just introduced a Harmonize (beta) feature in the beta that will greatly help blend dissimilar images.

Would you use the harmonize tool to get the head to match the body?

Yes, you can use the new Harmonize (beta) feature to help blend elements in a composite. It creates a new layer with the harmonized information so it's not as flexible if you then want to reposition the individual elements, but you could always re-harmonize them after repositioning.

Erik: a wonderful presentation. Can you clarify what you mean by "stamp it up" vs. "flatten image". Ty.

Sure, flattening will merge all layers and discard what you did before that, whereas stamping up creates a flattened layer of all the layers below while keeping the others.

Erik: where do you place your personal skies to make them available for Ps?

I have them in a Skies folder in my Photos folder, but they can be anywhere. I like to keep them organized, though.

JWLE

Last question for an excellent lecture. After you did a generative expand, you made a selection that enhances the resolution (?) for the new area. Can you clarify? With appreciation, Eric

When you do "generative" anything, it will give you a low-resolution preview. To match a higher resolution to the file, you have to (as of now) click that button next to it to increase the resolution. Hopefully, that will change in the future.

The image is always converted into an image that can be edited in Ps with the same quality/resolution, whether it's a smart object or not. Raw files cannot be edited destructively.

I would just run the File > Optimize Catalog function, and let that run. If that works without a problem, then the catalog should be in good shape.

Rob, I missed it on your screen. Do you check "Store presets with this catalog?" Why or why not?

I don't store presets with catalog. I like to keep them all in a central location shared with Camera Raw.

June Norsworthy

For Rob: When you have your external editor presets copied and you import them into another computer for using in LRC, don't these Editor Presets (like On1 or Topaz, or Retouch4me have to be installed already on that computer you are copying them to?

For external editors (basically other image editing programs), you just need to install that program on the other computer and that typically will create/install the plugins into LrC.



June Norsworthy

I do like that you put files on a different location, such as the Dropbox on your local drive. However, I tried that and it filled up my HD, so what do you recommend as a workaround?

First, if your primary internal drive is short on space you want to safely and methodically create more free space by moving large files to another drive. Once you have more free space, I would keep copies of these essential files on another drive, like an external.

I've tried colorize and sometimes it just skips an area (like an arm)...Can I make it focus on one area to fix it?

What you might try is to go ahead and colorize the image, then go back, select just the area it missed, press Command-J (on Mac, or Ctrl-J on Windows), to put just that area up on its own layer and then try running colorize again. It might do the trick.

To be honest, I don't have that much kit when I do this. One light, a light stand, camera bag, and modifiers fit easily into a long roller bag, which fits into the car.

If the idea is to 'match the scene' with a flash, then is the whole idea of using a flash is to fill? Effectively balancing the existing light?

It's not 'fill' as I'm doing more than filling shadows to get detail; I'm lighting the entire subject adding highlight and shadow by the position of the light.

David from Dallas, TX

On light stands do you find yourself bringing lighter light stands for the obvious weight reduction making them easier to carry, or something heavier like a C stand that handle wind better?

I prefer lighter, light stands and tend to use sandbags but filled with gravel... otherwise one of the group will hold the light stand as you saw in the video.

NornG

Glyn, do you use color correction on the flash when using out door flash?

Only if there's a definite light cast ... i.e., sunset. Then I would warm the light up.

If you're talking about the AI "Harmonize" tool, I prefer manual harmonization. Which is what the entire session was about. I much prefer to train our eyes to harmonize things manually. Otherwise, you can use the Sky Replacement Foreground/Sky lighting adjustment in the initial Sky Replacement window

Hi Dennis, What is a Color Check Layer? It is such a wonderful tool to apply, but I am not sure of how to make a color check layer, Thank you for the good explanation of Harmonize & esp. its current limitations in Ps Beta.

June, Great question! The Color Check is actually 2 layers, one filled with 50% gray set to Luminosity Blending. The other is a Hue'Saturation Adjustment Layer we use to push the Saturation. This lets us see just the colors in the image. When I use this technique I put them in a Layer Group so it's easy to toggle them on and off.

Hi Deborah, Are you photographing the flamingos in Merritt Island NWR? If so what area are you finding them?

Yes, but not on Black Point Drive. The flamingos are just north of that area on an island accessible by boat or kayak. You can launch at Bairs Cove off of Haulover Canal. There is a large population of manatees there in the cooler months. The island is informally called Bird Island, a protected island by FWC. Deb, how do you decide when it's best to shoot video vs photos?

Great question! I will always find a way to make video work. I like light falling on the subject, so I arrange to be in the right place at the right time. Backlit videos can be stunning too. I generally will shoot both still and video any time I am out.

Bill Mitchell

Beautiful work, Deborah. Do you pan the camera or rely on a fast shutter speed (or both) to capture the images of birds in flight?

That's a great question. If I am hand-holding the lens, I'll pan with the birds. Often, I'll notice the opportunity for birds in flight as I'm shooting stills, and I'll switch over to video. I use the Wimberley gimbal for most of my panning shots or shoot handheld. The gear I use is at least 10 lbs, so it can be physically demanding. I recommend handholding, using a gimbal, or using a fluid head for limited panning. I also use a video fluid head for video, when I'm not in the water! Gimbals offer a tremendous amount of flexibility with stills and video.

Hi Deb. Does pre capture work alongside with auto capture on your Nikon?

Yes, you should be able to set up your camera for Pre Capture and also Auto Capture. Auto Capture is one of the overlooked features; it's basically a very sophisticated camera trap that works incredibly well for stills and video.

Does it matter if it Photoshop or Photoshop Beta in preferences?

If you are using Photoshop Beta you can set that to be the primary external editor in LrC, just be careful since it is beta software. Both Ps Beta and the release version of Ps use the same ACR plugin, so nothing more to do there. You would want to set Ps Beta's file handling preferences the same as I showed for this release version of Ps.

Rob regarding Camera Raw settings in Ps, I have the display color setting on P3 instead of the standard sRGB color space. Is that ok?

You may not see any visible difference, but for editing purposes, I would stick to 16-bit Prophoto in ACR (especially when going back and forth for editing in LrC).

Rob, How are you moving your image around without using your mouse while in the zoom window in camera raw? Is it a mac thing? I find the zoom window in raw very frustrating. This sure would make it easier! Thanks!

Ah, I use a Magic Mouse, which is a Mac mouse that the top can function like a touchpad, so I can physically move the mouse and cursor or I can drag my finger on the top of the mouse to move the image around (instead of having to hold down the space bar, then click and drag with the mouse).

Scott With respect to removing the multiple areas of lens flare, to keep the maximum resolution for each, would it be better to do smaller selection areas?

Yes - if you're removing a large area, it's always best to do either smaller selections, or use the Enhance detail button to better match the overall resolution of the image.:-)

Does this Generative Fill use Adobe credits?

It does, but it matters which plan you're on, because you might have a whole bunch of credits, or an unlimited amount, or just a few per month. Check Adobe's site for which plans offer what amount of credits.



Scubatwig

Noticed it 'generated similar' from FireFly 3 - do you need to reset to FireFly1 when this was the source or base image for generate similar?

Yes, my bad on that. If you started with a FireFly 1 image, and you want to generate similar, make sure you're still on Firefly 1.

PhotoBob

Other than clicking in the upper left hand corner of the thumbnail of the Gen Fill selection to increase the resolution, is there anything else that can be done to further increase the resolution of the selection?

Yes, just use smaller selections. Instead of one big one, do smaller ones instead, and that helps a lot, resolution-wise.

Can you prompt like paint like a Degas?

I dunno know – give it a try. I mean, you can use that as a prompt, but will it paint like a Degas, well, you'll soon find out. LOL! :-)

Scott, will you have a handout for the 10 Things Gen Fill Can do for you?

I have something better – you have this course archived for an entire year, so you can come back and rewatch it anytime. A year from now, at the rate of speed Adobe's Gen Fill is changing, that's about it's lifespan and it'll probably be way outdated by then, but from now until then, you're set.

Is there a cheat sheet best words to use for the Generative Fill field?

There might be one out there, but I don't know where. It's a bit of trial and error for sure.

It changes it from a Gen Fill layer into a regular standard layer.

Scott is the high res render still doing the fix at 1080×1080?

Yeah, it's still there (I thought it would have been higher by now - it's been two years), so make sure you take advantage of the Enhance Detail feature, and if it's a big area you need to have it fill, cut it up into smaller pieces.

Scott - When you use Generative Fill and click on enhance detail afterward, and it says the area is too small, does that mean you don't need to worry about the resolution in that area?

Well, that's a fair question. I guess it feels like the area falls well within the 1080×1080 resolution boundary – if it's more than that, it lets you use enhance detail, but either way, we don't really have a choice. It either lets us do it, or not, which is probably not what you wanted to hear. LOL! Sorry about that.

When I get around to modifying an image, I am trying to remember what to do. I search around for the specific details on Google, Youtube, KelbyOne, etc. Instead, is there a way to ask Ps AI for details on how to do a specific modification?

Using Generative AI in Photoshop is all about the direction you give it. Your prompt is how you tell the AI what you want to change in your image. A more detailed prompt gives the AI clearer guidance. Try to include as many details as possible in your prompt.

Can you do a sky replacement in a Pano, and what sesquence?

Yes, you can do sky replacements in panos, it doesn't always work as well because of resolution, so its often best to use your own sky photos that are higher resolution. You would do this after merging and straightening. Do it right before color correction, because sky replacement will change the colors.
